

Accessing Speech-to-Text on the IPad

Here's what to do:

- 1. Launch the Settings app.
- 2. Tap on General.
- 3. Scroll down to the bottom and tap on Keyboard.
- 4. Toggle Dictation to On.
- 5. Tap Enable to agree to Apple's privacy notification.
- 6. If you're worried about the privacy notification, tap About and read the details.
- 7. Tap Done when you're satisfied.

Accessing Text-to-Speech on the IPad

Here's what to do:


- 1. Click on Settings > General > Accessibility > Speak Selection.
- 2. Switch Speak Selection to On.
- 3. A range of new options will appear. ...
- 4. You can adjust the Speaking Rate to your preferred speed.
- 5. The Highlight Words option (On by default) enables you to identify words as they are read out loud.



You can change the speaking rate to faster or slower!


Accessing the Read Out Loud function on IPads
